- in the Canadian Armed Forces, the Commonwealth or its wartime allies; or
- as a Class "C" Reservist; or
- as a Class "B" Reservist for a period of 3 years; or
- as a Class "A" Reservist for a period of 10 years; or
- as a regular member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police; or
- as a Peace Officer in a Special Duty Area, or on a special duty operation; or
- in the Merchant Navy or Ferry Command during wartime.

To receive a Veteran Plate this application form must be verified and submitted, with the required registration application to your local Motor Registration Division office.
